

Stacking Chairs in the Roller Rack

At the end of meetings and events, it is common for everyone to volunteer and carry folded chairs out to the roller racks that hold the chairs.

The placement of the first chair on each side of the roller rack needs to be properly positioned.

This may seem to be a trivial thing but failure to put the Clubhouse folding chairs into the rolling racks properly could result in the chairs falling out and harming someone.

The important step is placing the first chair in the bottom of the rack.



You will note that there is a pin on the center frame on each side of the roller rack. The first chair needs to be inserted such that the chair leg is under the pin.

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Note the longer leg is below the pin. This means the curve of the chair back is pointed downward.



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If all the chairs are placed in the same way, the last chair on a full rack side will be horizontal.

If the first chair is placed over the pin, as additional chairs are stacked on the rack, the chairs will start to tilt out of the rack. We have been lucky that improperly stacked chairs have not tilted out of the rack.

As we have no Chair Czar, we sometimes take too many chairs out of the Clubhouse. If both roller racks are full, we probably have removed too many chairs from the Clubhouse.

The dining area should have 18 chairs, six each at three round tables.

The card rooms should have enough chairs, four each, for the card tables in the rooms.

The help in removing chairs is greatly appreciated, let's just start the roller racks right.
